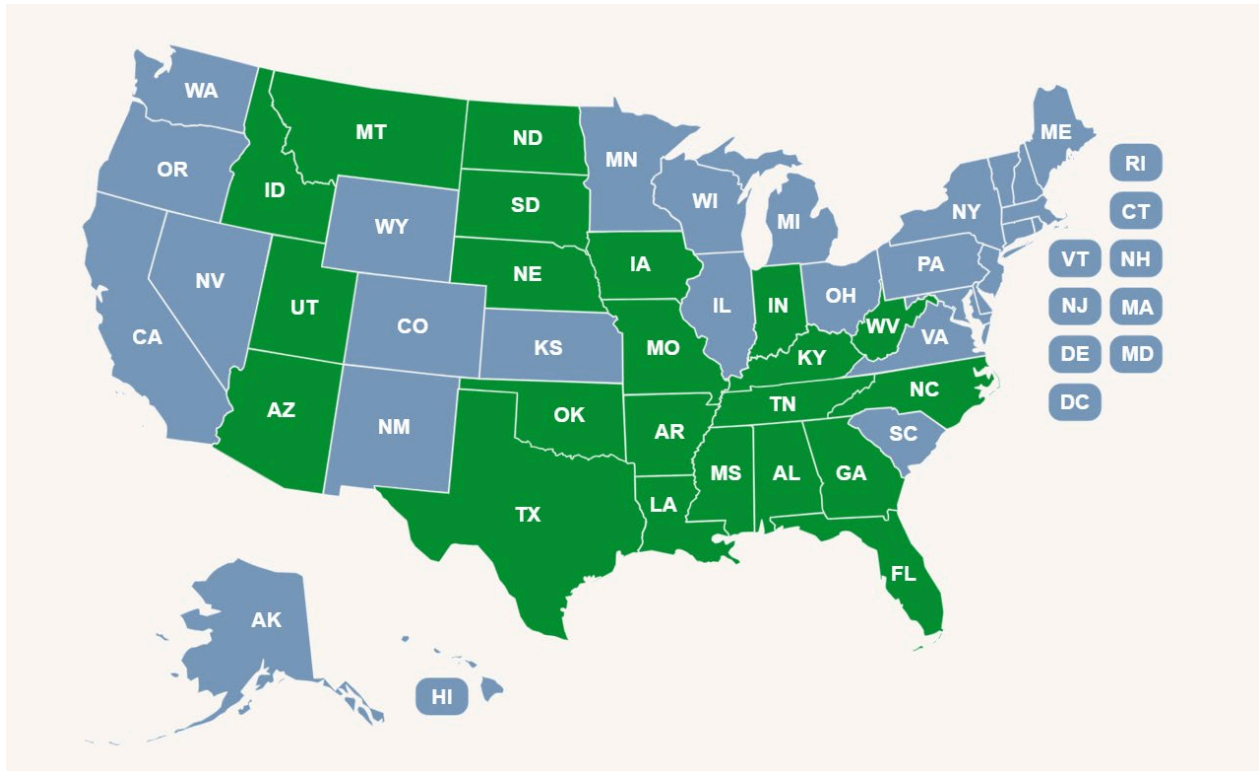


States that Protect Minors from Transgender Interventions

September 2023



As of September 2023, there are 22 states that have passed legislation protecting minors from transgender interventions. The majority of laws protect minors from the harms of puberty blockers, cross-sex hormones, and transgender surgeries. A few states have narrower regulations. The protective laws have been temporarily or permanently blocked by judges in four states, and the attorney general has refused to enforce the law in one.

State	Legislation	Date Passed	Notes
Alabama	SB184	4.7.2022	Prohibits transgender interventions for minors, protects parental rights, and establishes criminal penalties. *Hormone intervention prohibition temporarily blocked by judge.*
Arizona	SB1138	3.30.2022	Prohibits irreversible transgender surgeries for minors.

Arkansas	HB1570 Save Adolescents From Experimentation Act (SAFE Act)	4.13.2021	Prohibits transgender interventions for minors. *Permanently blocked by judge.*
Florida	SB254 Treatments for Sex Reassignment	5.17.2023	Gives the state court temporary emergency jurisdiction over a child that is being subjected to transgender interventions. *Enforcement temporarily blocked by judge.*
Georgia	SB140	3.23.2023	Prohibits hospitals from providing transgender interventions for minors.
Idaho	HB71 Vulnerable Child Protection Act	4.4.2023	Establishes felony offenses for transgender interventions on minors under the Child Protection Act.
Indiana	SB480 Gender Transition Procedures for Minors	4.5.2023	Prohibits transgender interventions for minors. *Hormone intervention prohibition temporarily blocked by judge.*
Iowa	SF538	3.22.2023	Prohibits practices on a minor for the purpose of altering the appearance of or affirming the perception of their gender.
Kentucky	SB150	3.29.2023	Protects parent and student rights related to transgender interventions in the public school system.
Louisiana	HB648 Stop Harming Our Kids Act	7.18.2023 (effective 1.1.2024)	Prohibits practices on a minor for the purpose of altering the appearance of or affirming minor's perception of minor's sex. The law holds healthcare professionals accountable by providing child victims an opportunity to sue for damages.
Mississippi	HB1125 Regulate Experimental Adolescent Procedures Act	2.28.2023	Prohibits public funding or medicaid reimbursement for transgender interventions for minors.

Missouri	SB 49 Save Adolescents From Experimentation Act (SAFE Act)	6.7.2023	Prohibits transgender interventions for minors and revokes medical licenses for doing so.
Montana	SB 99 Youth Health Protection Act	5.28.2023	Prohibits transgender interventions as treatments for gender dysphoria in minors. Prohibits related public funding.
Nebraska	LB574 Let Them Grow Act	5.22.2023	Prohibits transgender interventions for minors and allows for civil action against violators.
North Carolina	S639 Youth Health Protection Act	8.16.2023	Prohibits transgender interventions for minors. Protects parental rights.
North Dakota	HB1254 The Prohibition of Certain Practices Against a Minor	4.19.2023	Prohibits transgender interventions for minors as punishable as a felony.
Oklahoma	SB613	5.1.2023	Prohibits transgender interventions for minors as punishable as a felony. *Attorney General signed binding agreement not to enforce ban.*
South Dakota	HB1080	2.14.2023	Prohibits transgender interventions on minors.
Tennessee	SB1	3.22.2023	Prohibits transgender interventions for the purpose of enabling a gender identity inconsistent with a child's sex.
Texas	SB 14	6.2.2023 (effective 9.1.2023)	Prohibits transgender interventions for minors and related public funding.
Utah	SB0016 Transgender Medical Treatments and Procedure Amendments	1.28.2023	Prohibits transgender surgeries, regulates hormonal interventions, and requires the DHHS to conduct a review of medical evidence.
West Virginia	HB2007	5.1.2023	Prohibits transgender surgeries and

			regulates hormonal interventions.
